

- Registration for St. James Catholic Global Learning Centre for the 2025-2026 school year for Full Day Kindergarten to Grade 8 will take place **Monday, January 13 to Thursday, January 16, 2025**. To be considered for random selection, registrations must be received by 3:00 p.m. on Thursday, January 16, 2025.
- Registrations received by email to the St.JamesInfo@dpcdsb.org will receive confirmation of receipt within 48 hours of registration closing date. Parents/guardians are directed to contact the school if a receipt is not received by January 21, 2025.
- If bringing registration form and supporting documentation in person to the school, please leave in secure mailbox to the left of the front door.
- Random Selection date Tuesday, February 4, 2025
- Information regarding the status of the application will be communicated by Friday, February 21, 2025 via the email address as identified by the parent/guardian on the registration form.
- 2024-2025 waitlist (generated on February 14, 2024) is valid until 3:59:59 pm on reorganization day of September 2025 (date TBD).
- 2025-2026 waitlist (generated on February 4, 2025) is valid at 4:00 pm on reorganization day of September 2025 (date TBD).

- The St. James Catholic Global Learning Centre is an **optional, regional program** with limited spaces.
- There is no busing to St James Catholic Global Learning Centre.
- Registration is open to students eligible to attend a Dufferin Peel Catholic District elementary school.
- Class sizes are in line with Ministry mandates and determined by board wide averages. Kindergarten to grade 3 classes are capped at 23 students and grade 4 to 8 at 27 students.
- St James does not offer online registration. The DPCDSB registration package can be downloaded at <u>Printable Registration Form</u>, obtained via an email request at <u>St.JamesInfo@dpcdsb.org</u> or call the school office (905-891-7619) to arrange for pick-up of printed copies. Registration Form and supporting documents (as listed on the Registration tab of the board website) can be sent via email to <u>St.JamesInfo@dpcdsb.org</u>
- For students applying for the first time in Dufferin Peel Catholic District School Board, it is recommended that the student also be registered at the home school.
- Residents outside of Dufferin Peel are not eligible for the random selection process. All outside residents must be catholic and their registrations will be added to the bottom of the waitlist after the random selection process.

• Registrations received after the registration deadline will be accepted up until 3:00 p.m. the Friday before the start of the new school year. As these registrations were not included in the random selection they will be added to the bottom of the waitlist in order of receipt. No registrations will be accepted after 3:00 p.m. on the Friday before the new school year starts.

Random Selection

- In the event the number of applications exceeds the number of allotted spaces, complete applications received by the due date will be subject to the random selection process.
- A waitlist will be generated from the random selection and will be valid until the reorganization day of the following school year.
- If the number of applications does not exceed the allotment of spaces in the program, the application will be complete, and the Parent/Guardian will be notified by school staff of the student's acceptance to the Catholic Global Learning Program.
- Siblings of students currently registered in the program will also be subject to the random selection process to ensure equity of access to the regional program. In the case of an application by same-age/same-grade siblings (twin siblings), one application per sibling must be submitted.
- Information regarding the status of the application will be communicated within a week of the random selection process results, via the email address or mail address as identified by the parent/guardian.
- The school will generate a waitlist for consideration should spaces become available during the remainder of the school year. The waitlist will be valid until the reorganization day of the following school year.
- If a spot becomes available, the school will contact the first waitlist applicant. Said applicant will have 48 (forty-eight) hours to accept the spot. After 48 (forty-eight) hours, the school will contact the next applicant on the waitlist.
- Residents outside of Dufferin Peel are not eligible for the random selection process. All outside residents must be catholic and their registrations will be added to the bottom of the waitlist after the random selection process.
